LITTLESUGAR

The hollers and ravines on the west side of Bella Vista have also been opened up to the exploration of the new Little Sugar trail system. The current 50-mile open network takes trail users under bluffs along Sugar Creek and to a waterfall on Tanyard Creek as it wraps its way around Windsor and Avalon Lakes. Expect plenty of switchbacks and berms, as well as more advanced features like drops and jumps that have been generously sprinkled in throughout the system.

BACK 40

Enjoy a unique trail experience while riding the Back 40. Not only will you get the feeling of a backcountry ride, but also long segments of traditional singletrack trail. This system is mostly intermediate level (blue square) riding with sections of advanced/expert level (black diamond) riding.

BLOWING SPRINGS

At Blowing Springs you will experience a mix of flowy and technical riding. You will get mix of rollers, rock gardens/drops, and singletrack as you experience this system. Blowing Springs is the gateway to the Back 40, so loop Blowing Springs, or continue to the back country.

LAKE BELLA VISTA

The Lake Bella Vista Trails are your escape from the greenway. As you follow the greenway to Blowing Springs hop on to one of the trails here. Trails range from easy (green circle) to advanced/expert (black diamond). The Lake Bella Vista Bluff Trail has some of the most photographed bluff trail sections in NWA. Try your skills on the upper trail Smugglers Run. Do not miss it while riding the Greenway trail around the east side of Lake Bella Vista.

SLAUGHTER PEN

Slaughter Pen is the ultimate urban mountain bike park. Begin your ride in downtown Bentonville and experience a trail system for everyone. These trails contains a combination of clean flow, technical rocks, major downhills and huge berms. Slaughter Pen is an IMBA Silver Level Ride Center and ranges from easy (green circle) to advanced/expert (black diamond).

PARK SPRINGS PARK

Park Springs, one of Bentonville's oldest recreation areas that opened to the public in 1916, is entering a new phase of life with a system of MTB trails. While still part of Slaughter Pen, the jump line in this trail behind Lincoln Junior High is worth mentioning. Come check out the newly redesigned Burns Arboretum Nature Trail, and enjoy the view of native Ozark flora.

COLER

Coler is a system that is pushing the limits of riders and builders alike. This system caters to intermediate and professional level riders. In the heart of Coler lies the area's first double black diamond jump. In addition to the thrill, we recommend paying close attention to the rock work and architectural features. Not looking to hit the gravity trails? No problem. Take in the beauty of the property by riding on the system's cross country singletrack trail. The Coler trail system can be accessed just a few miles from beautiful downtown Bentonville.
